## CHAPERONE RESPONSIBILITIES AT YOUTH VOLLEYBALL TOURNAMENT

1. Chaperones will oversee participants assigned to them for the entire trip from the time they leave home until they return home after the trip.
2. Chaperones should be in contact with their Instructor or Group Leader for the schedule for the day.
3. Chaperones should make sure that participants get checked in to the hotel and check their room to make sure there are no problems.
4. Chaperones should be sure participants get to the gym, the hotel, the banquet hall during the weekend.
5. Chaperones should make sure participants have their equipment, clothes to play in and knee pads and are ready to leave when it is time to go.
6. When arriving at the gym, Chaperones should make sure that all participants are checked in according to the COVID protocols that are put in place for the tournament. That is, make sure that Adults have proof of vaccination and that everyone has their temperature taken upon arrival. The Chaperone is responsible for anyone who does not pass the temperature test and must remove the participant from the gym immediately.
7. At the gym, Chaperones should make sure participants are behaving themselves, are ready to play when their team is up, make sure they do not go roaming around outside, and make sure they clean up after themselves when leaving the gym each day.
8. Chaperones should make sure participants are hydrated.
9. Chaperones should make sure players are taken care of if they get hurt. Be sure to let the National Physical Education Director know what is happening.
10. A chaperone should be with the athletes at all times. You are particularly responsible for the participants at the hotel and Nest hall.  
Boys should not be in girl's rooms or girls in boy's rooms without a chaperone in or nearby and with the doors propped open.  
A curfew should be set by the chaperones and chaperones should enforce it by checking rooms when it is time for bed. Know that 11:00 p.m. is quiet time at the hotel. Also know that play begins early on Saturday morning and people need to be rested.

11. Chaperones should, upon check out, make sure that there is no damage to each participant's room.

Chaperones need to remember that they oversee the participants for the weekend and should take this role seriously. If you have any problems, please contact your Instructor or Group Leader first and then you can contact Druhna Chris.
